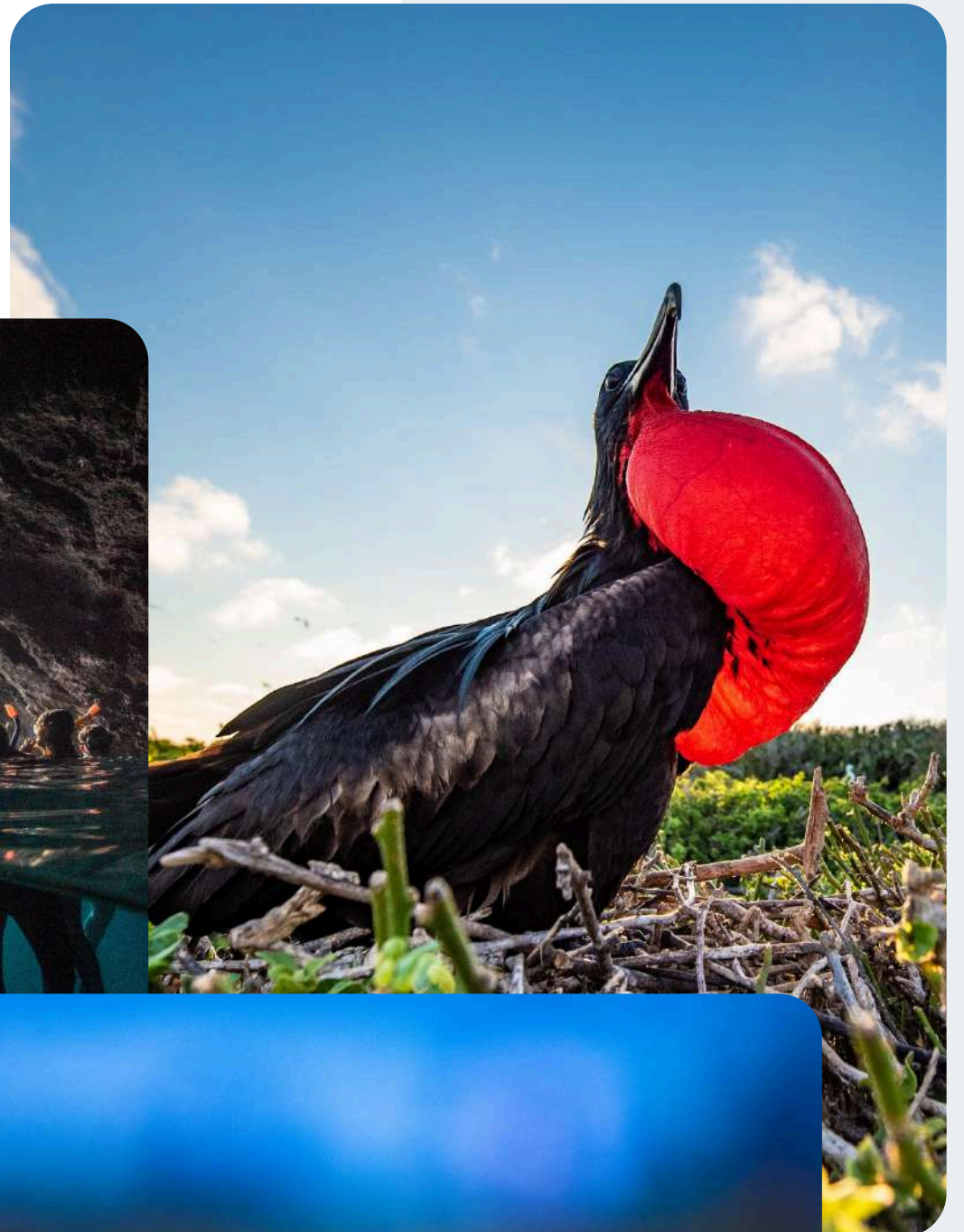
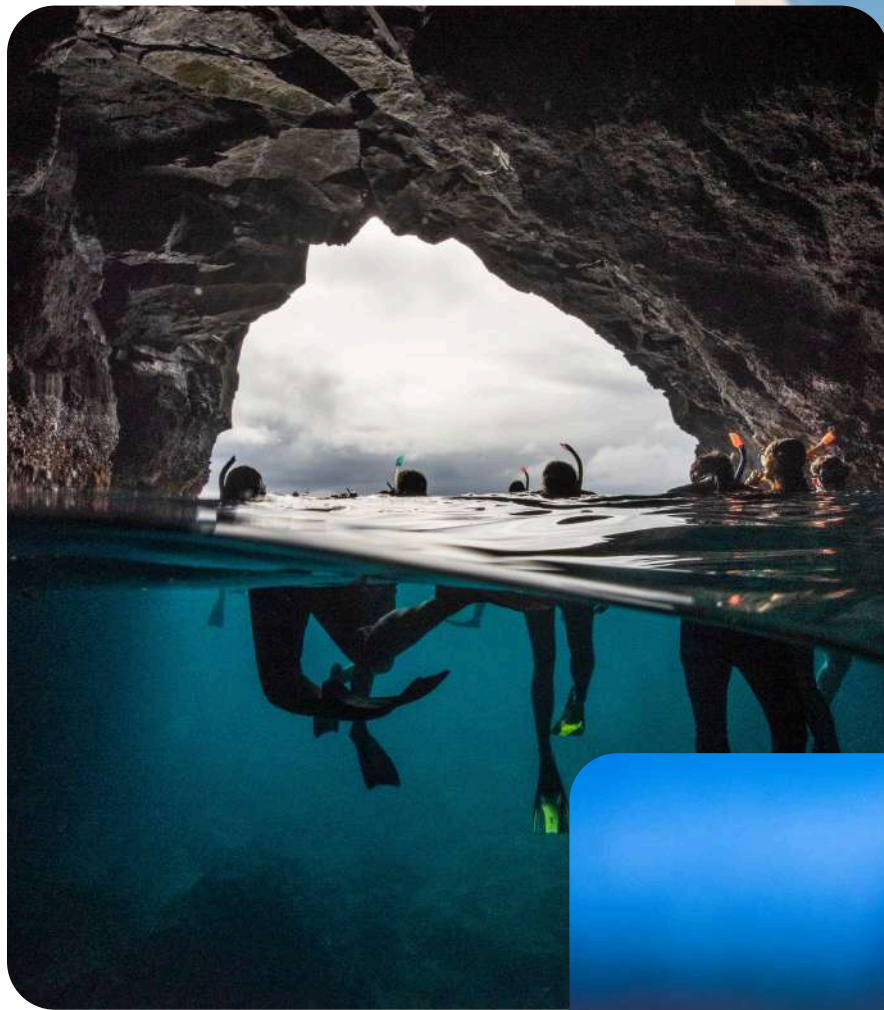

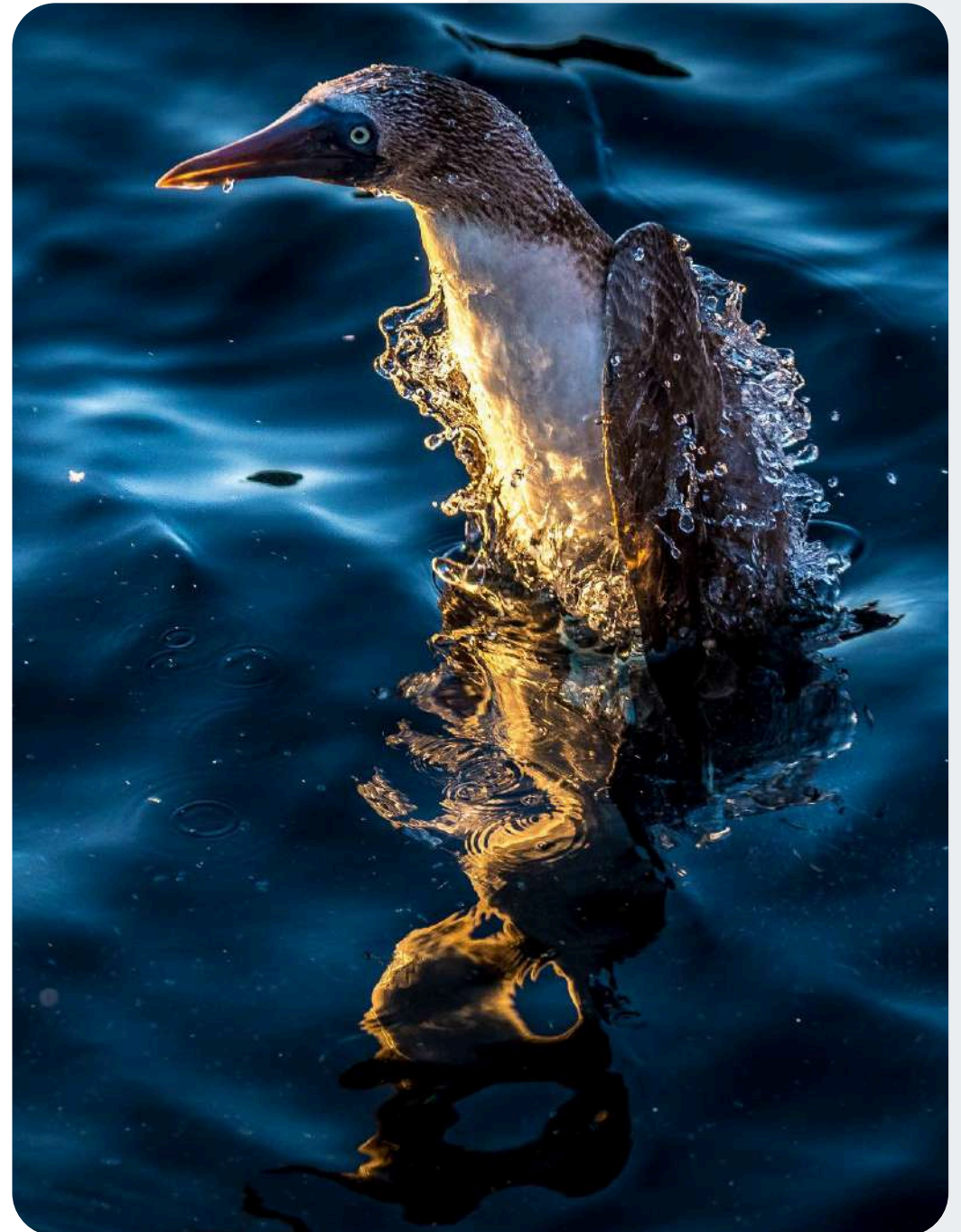

Biodiversity:

One of the largest concentrations of endemism (species unique to the planet) may be found on the Galapagos Islands. You will find more than 80% of endemic land birds, 97% of endemic reptiles and terrestrial mammals, and more than 30% of endemic plants. The islands are home to the only species of penguin found in the Northern Hemisphere.



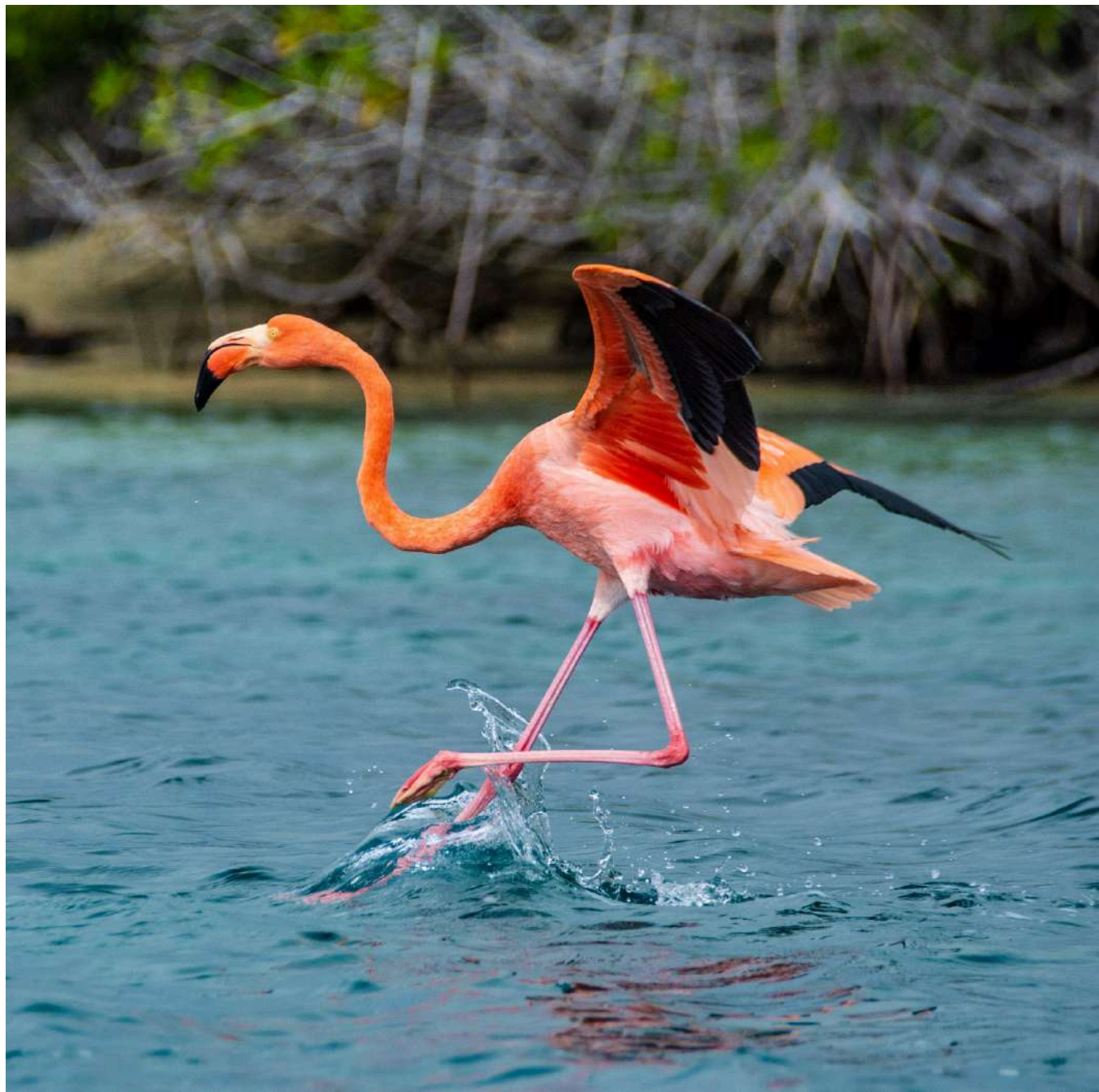
Insular Region

3% of the national territory





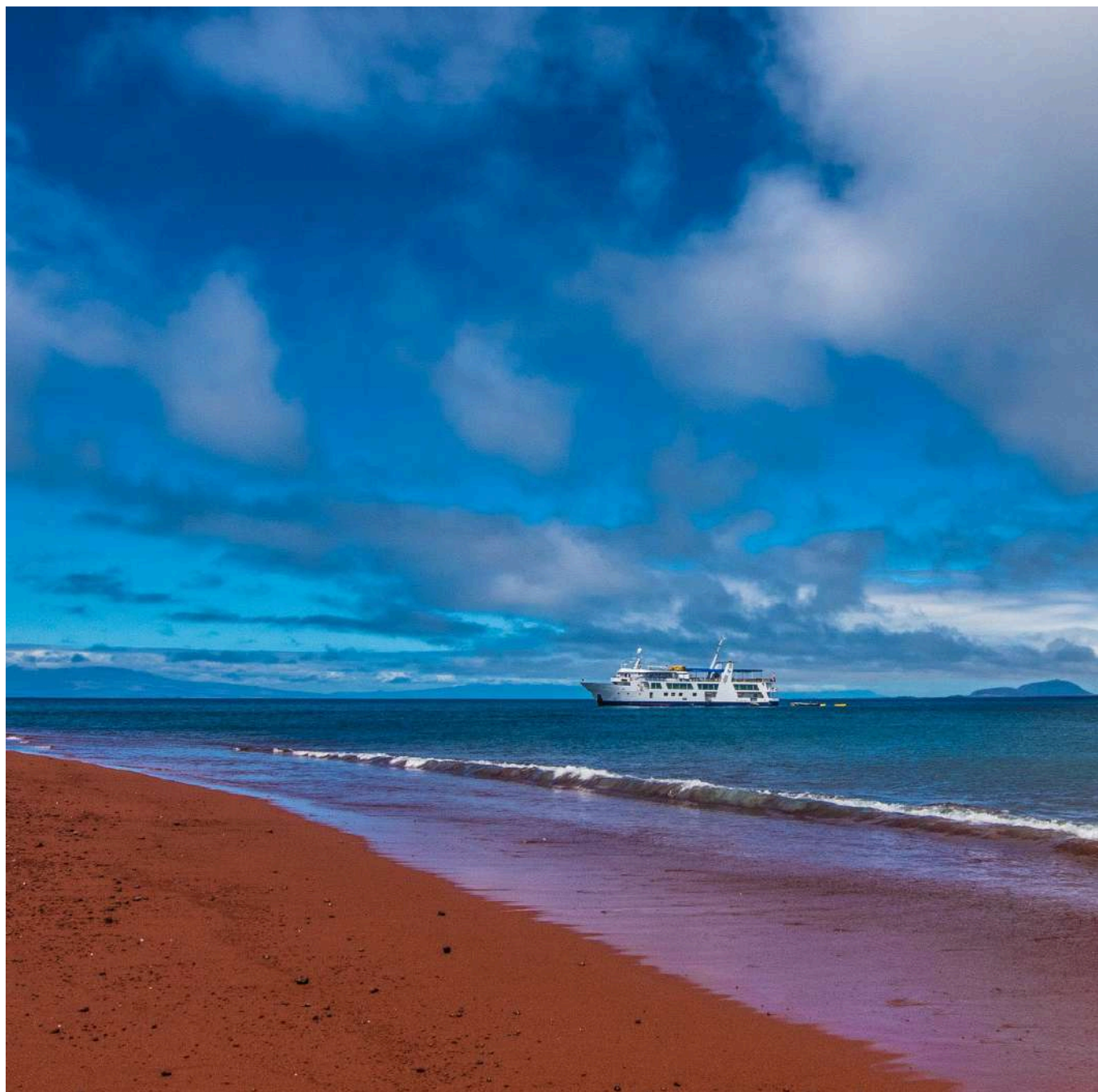
Climate
